JUDGMENT

This case was heard upon the record of appeal from the Knox County Chancery Court, briefs and argument of counsel; and upon consideration thereof, this Court is of the opinion that the trial court properly affirmed the hearing panel's finding that Thomas Fleming Mabry violated Tennessee Rules of Professional Conduct 1.3 and 8.4(a) and should be suspended from the practice of law for forty-five days.

In accordance with the opinion filed therein, it is therefore ordered and adjudged that the judgment of the Knox County Chancery Court is affirmed. It is further ordered that, pursuant to Tenn. Sup.Ct. R. 9, § 24.3, Thomas Fleming Mabry shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter and, in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs herein, for which execution may issue if necessary.
