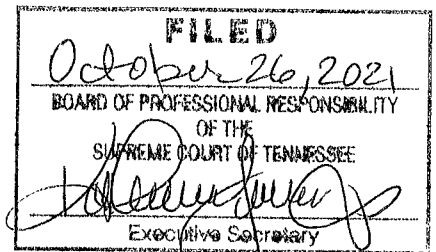



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Respondent's conduct (which was alleged as File No. 59125-5-SC) was, under the circumstances found by the Panel in the Order, in violation of RPC 4.4(a)(1) and 8.4 (c) and the Respondent shall be publicly censured for such conduct.

Except for the matter considered here, all other matters in this case are expressly reserved.
