REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

This matter was heard on September 19, 2017, in a telephone conference call before a Panel of the Board of Professional Responsibility, consisting of Joe M. Looney, Chair, Bridget J. Willhite, and Jeffrey S. Henry. The Panel considered the Petition for Dissolution of Order of Temporary Suspension filed by Robert L. Marlow on or about September 1, 2017. Mr. Marlow represented himself in the telephonic conference. The Board of Professional Responsibility was represented by Alan D. Johnson.

The Panel considered the Supreme Court's Order of Temporary

Suspension filed on August 25, 2017, the Petition for Dissolution of Order of Temporary

Suspension filed by Robert L. Marlow, the Affidavit of Robert Lee Marlow filed on or about

September 18, 2017, the testimony of Robert L. Marlow, the statements of counsel, and the

entire record in the cause, from all of which the Panel concludes that the Petition for

Dissolution filed by Robert L. Marlow is well-taken. While the Panel does not condone Mr.

Marlow's failure to respond to the disciplinary complaint in a timely manner, nor does it find

particularly persuasive his argument as to why he did not timely respond, nevertheless, the

Panel believes that the Petition for Dissolution is well-taken and recommends that the Temporary Suspension be dissolved. The Panel also notes that disciplinary counsel for the Board of Professional Responsibility indicated that the Board had no objection to the dissolution of the Order of Temporary Suspension.
