ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 24.3, Venita Martin shall pay to the Board of Professional the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$621.60, within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, and in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.
- 3. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this discipline to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18.10.
- 4. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18.5, this Order shall be effective ten (10) days after the date of entry.
