**ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT**

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed against Kelvin Arthur Massey on August 5, 2022; upon Respondent's Response to the Petition for Discipline filed on September 26, 2022; upon the Final Judgment of the Hearing Panel Including Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law issued November 27, 2023; upon the Executive Secretary of the Board's service of the Hearing Panel's Final Judgment upon Mr. Massey on November 27, 2023; upon the Board's Application for Assessment of Costs filed December 12, 2023; upon the Hearing Panel's Findings and Judgment for Assessment of Costs entered on January 16, 2024; upon the Executive Secretary of the Board's service of the Hearing Panel's Findings and Judgment for Assessment of Costs upon Respondent on January 17, 2024; upon consideration and approval by the Board on March 8, 2024; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which, the Court approves and adopts the Final Judgment, including Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and the Hearing Panel's Findings and Judgment for Assessment of Costs as the Court's Order.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

(1) Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.4 (2014), Kelvin Arthur Massey; is hereby publicly censured.

(2) Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 31.3(d), Mr. Massey shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs incurred to date by the Board in this matter in the amount of \$1,988.50. In addition to these costs, Mr. Massey shall be assessed a separate \$100.00 fee for filing this matter. Mr. Massey shall pay this filing fee to the Board and shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the court costs incurred herein.

(3) Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 31.3(d), all costs, fees, and expenses awarded or assessed herein shall be paid within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order

for which execution, if necessary, may issue.

(4) The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this discipline to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
