
PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaints were filed against Brett Nathaniel Mayes, #031762, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered this matter at its meeting on September 8, 2023.

Mr. Mayes served on a local planning commission, and he was required to complete a “Statement of Interest” form by the Tennessee Ethics Commission. Mr. Mayes falsely stated on the form that he had never filed bankruptcy when he had filed bankruptcy in 2019. Mr. Mayes completed the form for two calendar years, indicating on both filings that he had not filed bankruptcy. The forms were completed under penalty of perjury.

By the aforementioned acts, Brett Nathaniel Mayes is in violation of Rule of Professional Conduct 8.4(c) (conduct involving dishonesty) and is hereby Publicly Censured for these violations.
