LAUDERDALE COUNTY LAWYER TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED

On June 21, 2018, the Supreme Court of Tennessee temporarily suspended Jennifer Lynn Mayham from the practice of law upon finding that Ms. Mayham poses a threat of substantial harm to the public. Section 12.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9 provides for the immediate summary suspension of an attorney's license to practice law if an attorney poses a threat of substantial harm to the public.

Ms. Mayham is immediately precluded from accepting any new cases, and she must cease representing existing clients by July 21, 2018. After July 21, 2018, Ms. Mayham shall not use any indicia of lawyer, legal assistant, or law clerk nor maintain a presence where the practice of law is conducted.

Ms. Mayham must notify all clients being represented in pending matters, as well as co-counsel and opposing counsel, of the Supreme Court's Order suspending her law license. Ms. Mayham is required to deliver to all clients any papers or property to which they are entitled.

This suspension remains in effect until dissolution or modification by the Supreme Court. Ms. Mayham may for good cause request dissolution or modification of the suspension by petition to the Supreme Court.

ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court on a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Jennifer Lynn Mayham from the practice of law, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the Affidavit of Jason Randall Poyner, Assistant District Attorney for the 25th Judicial District.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting Affidavit, the Court finds that Jennifer Lynn Mayham, Respondent, poses a threat of substantial harm to the public as evidenced by her appearance in court under the influence of illegal drugs as detailed by the Affidavit of Jason Randall Poyner.

IT IS THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

1. Jennifer Lynn Mayham is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3.
2. Jennifer Lynn Mayham shall comply with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9 in all respects and particularly as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28, regarding the responsibilities of suspended attorneys.
3. Jennifer Lynn Mayham may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3.
4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Jennifer Lynn Mayham to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
