NASHVILLE LAWYER TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED

On January 25, 2010, the Tennessee Supreme Court temporarily suspended the law license of Jerry Maynard, II, of Nashville, Tennessee, pursuant to Section 4.3 of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9. The Board of Professional Responsibility petitioned the Court to temporarily suspend Maynard's law license because he failed to respond to a complaint of ethical misconduct.

Effective January 25, 2010, Mr. Maynard is precluded from accepting any new clients and must cease representing existing clients by February 25, 2010. After February 25, 2010, Mr. Maynard shall not use any indicia of lawyer, legal assistant, or law clerk nor maintain a presence where the practice of law is conducted.

Mr. Maynard must notify all clients he represents in pending legal matters, as well as co-counsel and opposing counsel, of the Supreme Court's Order suspending his law license. Section 18 of Supreme Court Rule 9 requires Mr. Maynard to deliver to all clients any papers or property to which they are entitled.

This suspension remains in effect until dissolution or modification by the Supreme Court. Mr. Maynard may, for good cause, request dissolution or modification of the suspension by petition to the Supreme Court. If he makes such an application, a hearing to consider whether the suspension should be continued, modified or dissolved will be conducted before a panel of the Board of Professional Responsibility.

ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Jerry Maynard, II, from the practice of law, pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the Affidavit of Rachel Waterhouse, Deputy Chief Disciplinary Counsel in Investigations.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting Affidavit, the Court finds that Jerry Maynard, II, Respondent, poses a threat of substantial harm to the public.

It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court:

- 1. That Jerry Maynard, II is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9.
- 2. That Jerry Maynard, II comply with Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects, and particularly as provided in Section 18.
- 3. That Jerry Maynard, II may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Supreme Court Rule 9.
- 4. That the Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Jerry Maynard, II to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9.
