ORDER

By Order of Temporary Suspension entered April 28, 2010, Matthew Fort Mayo was temporarily suspended from the practice of law pursuant to Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 4.3, for failure to respond to a complaint of misconduct filed against him by the Board of Professional Responsibility ("Board"). On April 28, 2010, Mr. Cundiff filed a Petition for Dissolution of Temporary Order of Suspension asserting that he has responded to the complaint and asking that this Court enter an Order of Dissolution. Section 4.3 requires an immediate hearing before the Board of Professional Responsibility or an appropriately-constituted Panel, with the Panel to submit its report and recommendation to the Court "with the utmost speed consistent with due process".

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Board take appropriate steps to comply with Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 4.3. This Court will not take action until the report and recommendation of the Panel is received.
