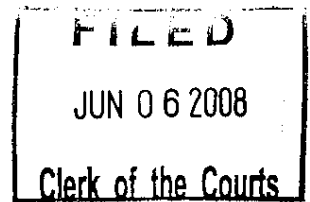

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**ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT**

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed by the Board of Professional Responsibility ("the Board") against Respondent, Thomas Keith McAlexander, on June 10, 2005; upon Answer filed by Respondent on August 9, 2005; upon Order for Partial Summary Judgment filed on October 9, 2007; upon hearing before a Hearing Panel; and upon the entire record in this cause.


From all of which the Court accepts the Findings and Judgment of the Hearing Panel and adopts the recommendations contained therein as the Court's Order.

It is therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Respondent is disbarred from the practice of law in Tennessee effective ten (10) days from the entry of this Order.
2. Respondent shall comply in all aspects with Rule 9, §18 of the Rules of the Supreme Court regarding the obligations and responsibilities of disbarred attorneys.
3. Should Respondent seek reinstatement of his law license, Respondent shall comply in all respects with the requirements of Rule 9, § 19 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
4. Pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent shall pay to the Board the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$883.81, and in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue, if necessary.

5. The Board shall cause notice of this disbarment to be published as required by Rule 9, §18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
