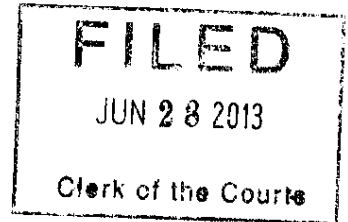

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed on November 5, 2012 by the Board of Professional Responsibility ("Board") against Thomas Holland McKinnie, Jr.; upon Mr. McKinnie's Answer to the Petition for Discipline filed on November 26, 2012; upon a Conditional Guilty Plea filed on May 3, 2013; upon an Order of Recommendation of Conditional Guilty Plea filed on May 8, 2013; upon the Board's consideration of this matter on June 14, 2013; and upon the entire record of this cause.

From all of which the Court accepts the Order of the Hearing Panel and adopts the Order of the Hearing Panel as the Court's Order.

It is therefore, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that:

1. Thomas Holland McKinnie, Jr. shall be suspended for two (2) years, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 4.2.
2. Mr. McKinnie shall comply in all aspects with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 18 and § 19 regarding the obligations and responsibilities of suspended attorneys, and the procedure for reinstatement.
3. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9 § 18.5, this Order shall be effective ten (10) days after the date of entry.
4. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 24.3, Mr. McKinnie shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$407.45 and shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.

5. The Board shall cause notice of this discipline to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. Rule 9, § 18.10.
