LOUISIANA ATTORNEY SUSPENDED FROM PRACTICE OF LAW

Scott Eason Meece, a Louisiana attorney, has been placed on interim suspension from the practice of law in this state by the Order of the Supreme Court entered November 21, 2007. The Court suspended Meece based upon a Petition filed by the Board of Professional Responsibility alleging that the Supreme Court of Louisiana had entered an Order on May 9, 2007 suspending Meece from the practice of law on an interim basis for threat of harm to the public.

Section 18 of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9 requires Meece to notify by registered or certified mail all clients being represented in pending matters; all co-counsel and opposing counsel of the Supreme Court's Order suspending him. Section 18 also requires Meece to deliver to all clients any papers or property to which they are entitled.

This suspension shall remain in effect until it is dissolved or amended by Order of the Supreme Court of Tennessee.
