## PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against John R. Meldorf, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered this matter at its meeting on September 8, 2017.

Mr. Meldorf collected funds as a creditor from a bankruptcy trustee even though such funds were properly owed to his former client. Mr. Meldorf failed to promptly notify his former client upon receipt of such funds and paid himself fees owed by the former client without her knowledge or consent.

By these acts, John R. Meldorf has violated Rules of Professional Conduct 1.15(d) and (e) (safekcoping property) and is hereby Publicly Censured for these violations.
