WILLIAMSON COUNTY LAWYER TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED

On September 24, 2026, the Supreme Court of Tennessee temporarily suspended Mitchell Ray Miller from the practice of law upon finding that Mr. Miller failed to respond to the Board of Professional Responsibility concerning six (6) complaints of misconduct.

Mr. Miller is currently suspended from the practice of law pursuant to an Order of Enforcement entered by the Supreme Court of Tennessee (Docket No. M2025-01282-SC-BAR-BP) on September 5, 2025, and prohibited from engaging in the practice of law or using any indicia of lawyer, legal assistant, or law clerk or maintaining a presence where the practice of law is conducted.

Mr. Miller, to the extent he has not complied with the Order of Enforcement entered previously, shall withdraw from all representation and deliver to all clients any papers or property to which they are entitled.

Mr. Miller shall comply with the requirements of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Sections 28 and 12.3(d), regarding the obligations and responsibilities of temporarily suspended attorneys and the procedure for dissolution or modification.

This temporary suspension remains in effect until dissolution or modification by the Supreme Court. Mr. Miller may, for good cause, request dissolution or modification of the temporary suspension by petition to the Supreme Court.
