**ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT**

This matter is before the Court upon a Notice of Submission filed by the Board of Professional Responsibility (“Board”) on November 25, 2024; upon an Order of Enforcement entered November 26, 2024; upon a Petition for Final Discipline filed on February 24, 2025; upon a Motion for Default Judgment and that Charges be Deemed Admitted filed on May 5, 2025; upon the hearing on the Motion for Default Judgment on September 9, 2025; upon the Order Granting Default Judgment on Petition for Final Discipline entered by the Hearing Panel on September 9, 2025; upon service of a copy of the Order Granting Default Judgment on Jocelyn Doria Mims by the Executive Secretary on September 9, 2025; upon the final hearing held on September 25, 2025; upon the Disciplinary Hearing Panel Final Decree entered on October 1, 2025; upon service of a copy of the Disciplinary Hearing Panel Final Decree on Ms. Mims by the Executive Secretary on October 1, 2025; upon the Board’s Application for Assessment of Costs filed on October 14, 2025; upon Findings and Judgment for Assessment of Costs entered by the Hearing Panel on November 4, 2025; upon service of a copy of the Findings and Judgment for Assessment of Costs on Ms. Mims by the Executive Secretary of the Board on November 4, 2025; upon consideration and approval by the Board on December 12, 2025; upon expiration of the appeal period with no appeal taken; and upon the entire record in this cause.

On November 26, 2024, Ms. Mims was suspended from the practice of law by this Court pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §22.3 (Case No. M2024-01764-SC-BAR-BP). To date, Ms. Mims has not requested nor been granted reinstatement.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

1. Jocelyn Doria Mims is permanently disbarred from the practice of law pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.1.

2. Ms. Mims shall comply with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9 in all respects and particularly as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28, regarding obligations and responsibilities of disbarred attorneys.

3. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §31.3(d), Ms. Mims shall pay to the Board the expenses and costs incurred to date by the Board in this matter in the amount of \$3,026.00. Ms. Mims shall be assessed \$100.00 for the cost of filing this matter and pay this filing fee to the Board and shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the court costs incurred herein. All costs, fees, and expenses awarded or assessed herein shall be paid within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.

4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this discipline to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.

5. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup Ct. R. 9, §28.1, this Order shall be effective upon entry.
