ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

This matter is before the Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c), upon a Petition for Reinstatement filed on November 21, 2025, by Petitioner, Carlos Eugene Moore. Mr. Moore was suspended from the practice of law by reciprocal Order of this Court entered March 27, 2025, for a period of one (1) year retroactive to the date of suspension in Mississippi, and subject to the conditions specified in the December 31, 2024, Opinion and Final Judgment of the Supreme Court of Mississippi. A Notice of Submission was filed by the Chief Disciplinary Counsel indicating the petition is satisfactory to the Board, that Mr. Moore is in compliance currently with the terms and conditions set forth in this Court's Order imposing reciprocal discipline, and that he is eligible for reinstatement effective January 1, 2026. From all of which, the Court grants the Petition for Reinstatement.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COURT:

1. The Petitioner, Carlos Eugene Moore, is hereby reinstated to the practice of law in the State of Tennessee pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c), effective January 1, 2026.
2. Mr. Moore shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for which execution, if necessary, may issue.
3. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
