WILLIAMSON COUNTY LAWYER PLACED ON DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS

By Order of the Tennessee Supreme Court entered August 21, 2012, the law license of Charles C. Morrow was transferred to disability inactive status pursuant to Section 21 of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9.

Mr. Morrow cannot practice law while on disability inactive status. He may return to the practice of law after reinstatement by the Tennessee Supreme Court upon showing of clear and convincing evidence that the disability has been removed and he is fit to resume the practice of law.

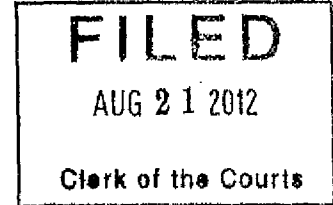

ORDER TRANSFERRING ATTORNEY TO DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS

This matter is before the Court upon the Petition to Transfer Attorney Charles Morrow, to disability inactive status pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 21.2.

Upon due consideration of medical documentation submitted by Johanna Bendell, M.D., and Steven D. Graham, M.D., the Court concludes that Charles Morrow is currently incapacitated from continuing the practice of law.

It is, therefore, ordered, adjudged, and decreed by the Court that:

1. The law license of Charles Morrow shall be transferred to disability inactive status for an indefinite period of time and until further orders of this Court.
2. Charles Morrow shall be allowed to petition for reinstatement to active status pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 21.6.
3. The Board shall publish notice of this transfer pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §§ 21.4 and 21.5.
4. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 25.2, documents other than this Order relating to Charles Morrow's disability proceeding shall not be public records and shall be kept confidential.
5. Costs are taxed to Charles Morrow.
