## ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

This matter is before the Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c), upon a Petition for Reinstatement filed on January 5, 2018, by the Petitioner, George Avery Mott. Mr. Mott was suspended from the practice of law by Order of this Court on December 27, 2017, for a period of thirty (30) days. - 3. Mr. Mott remains obligated to pay the expenses and costs set forth in the Order of Enforcement entered on December 27, 2017.
- 4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
