DAVIDSON COUNTY LAWYER REINSTATED

On February 8, 2018, the Supreme Court of Tennessee reinstated George Avery Mott to the practice of law. Mr. Mott had been suspended by the Supreme Court of Tennessee on December 27, 2017, for a period of one (1) year, with thirty (30) days to be served as an active suspension and the remaining time on probation. With entry of this Order, Mr. Mott begins the probationary period.

On January 5, 2018, Mr. Mott filed a Petition for Reinstatement to the practice of law pursuant to Tennessee Supreme Court, Rule 9, Section 30.4(c). The Board verified that the conditions required for reinstatement were satisfied and filed a Notice of Submission with the Supreme Court indicating Mr. Mott was eligible for reinstatement to the practice of law. The Order of Reinstatement entered February 8, 2018, was effective upon filing.

ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

This matter is before the Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c), upon a Petition for Reinstatement filed on January 5, 2018, by the Petitioner, George Avery Mott. Mr. Mott was suspended from the practice of law by Order of this Court on December 27, 2017, for a period of thirty (30) days. A Notice of Submission was filed by the Board of Professional Responsibility indicating Mr. Mott has satisfied all conditions set forth in the December 27, 2017, Order of Enforcement. Pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Order, the petition is satisfactory to the Board, and Mr. Mott is eligible for reinstatement effective January 26, 2018.

From all of which the Court grants the Petition for Reinstatement.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT:

1. The Petitioner, George Avery Mott, is hereby reinstated to the active practice of law in the State of Tennessee effective January 26, 2018, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §30.4(c).
2. Mr. Mott shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for which execution may issue if necessary.
3. Mr. Mott remains obligated to pay the expenses and costs set forth in the Order of Enforcement entered on December 27, 2017.
4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
