**ORDER TRANSFERRING ATTORNEY TO DISABILITY INACTIVE
STATUS AND STAYING CONDITIONAL ADMISSION ORDER**

This matter is before the Court upon a petition to transfer Carroll Alexandria Nail to disability inactive status and stay the conditional admission order filed by the Tennessee Board of Professional Responsibility pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 27.3.

Upon due consideration of representations, correspondence and medical records provided to the Board by Ms. Nail, the Court concludes that Carroll Alexandria Nail currently suffers from a disability by reason of medical infirmity or illness, which makes it impossible for her to continue to practice law. The Court further concludes that the conditional admission order dated February 2, 2023, and the terms and conditions contained therein should be stayed effective December 1, 2025.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

1. The law license of Carroll Alexandria Nail shall be transferred to disability inactive status for an indefinite period of time and until further orders of this Court.

2. The Conditional Admission Order dated February 2, 2023, and the terms and conditions contained therein, shall be stayed effective December 1, 2025, and until further order of this Court pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 7, § 10.05(h).

3. Any pending disciplinary proceeding shall be stayed until further order of this Court pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 27.3.

4. Ms. Nail shall comply with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9 in all respects and particularly as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28, regarding the responsibilities of attorneys transferred to disability inactive status.

5. Ms. Nail shall be allowed to petition for reinstatement to active status pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 27.7. Any reinstatement petition seeking removal of disability and/or a return to the active practice of law shall address the conditional admission order stayed herein.

6. Erica L. Smith, appointed practice monitor pursuant to the Conditional Admission Order, is relieved of all further duties and responsibilities as practice monitor for Ms. Nail.

7. The Board shall publish notice of this transfer pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §§ 27.5 and 28.11.

8. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 32.4 and Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 7, § 10.05(k), documents other than this Order relating to Ms. Nail's disability proceeding shall not be public records and shall be kept confidential.
