MEMPHIS LAWYER CENSURED

On January 19, 2011, Jamshid B. Naini of Memphis, Tennessee, was publicly censured by the Tennessee Supreme Court.

The Board of Professional Responsibility filed a Petition for Discipline against Mr. Naini pursuant to Rule 9 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Tennessee. Mr. Naini submitted a Conditional Guilty Plea that was approved by the Hearing Panel, the Board and the Supreme Court. Mr. Naini violated the Rules of Professional Conduct by sharing fees with non-lawyer employees in his office. Mr. Naini's actions violated the following Rules of Professional Conduct: 5.4 (Professional Independence of a Lawyer) and 8.4 (a) (Misconduct). Mr. Naini was further ordered to pay the costs of the disciplinary proceedings.

For these violations, the Supreme Court of Tennessee publicly censured Jamshid B. Naini. A public censure is a rebuke and warning to the attorney, but it does not affect the attorney's ability to practice law.

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed by the Board of Professional Responsibility against Respondent, Jamshid B. Naini, on May 12, 2010; upon the entering of a Conditional Guilty Plea by the Respondent on November 18, 2010; upon the approval of the Conditional Guilty Plea by the Hearing Panel on November 23, 2010; upon the approval of the Board of Professional Responsibility on December 11, 2010; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court approves the recommendation of the Hearing Panel and accepts the Conditional Guilty Plea.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court,

1. That Respondent is hereby publicly censured pursuant to Rule 9, section 4.4 of the Rules of the Supreme Court; and

2. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, section 24.3, the Respondent shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$1,189.86, and in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, within ninety (90) days from the entry of this order, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.

3. That the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court cause notice of this public censure to be published as required by Rule 9, §18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Tennessee.
