

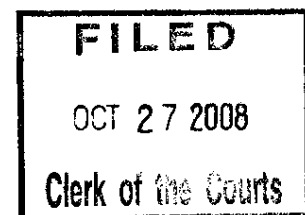

JUDGMENT



This cause came on to be heard upon the record on appeal from the Chancery Court for Davidson County, briefs and argument of counsel; and upon consideration thereof, this Court is of the opinion that the Hearing Panel did not err in finding that the appellant violated several disciplinary rules and in finding aggravating circumstances. This Court is also of the opinion that the appellant's six-month suspension is commensurate with sanctions imposed in similar cases and the relevant American Bar Association Standards for Imposing Lawyer Sanctions.

In accordance with the opinion filed herein, it is, therefore, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by this Court that the judgment of the Chancery Court for Davidson County affirming the Hearing Panel be and the same is hereby affirmed.

The costs of this appeal are taxed to the appellant, Ronald K. Nevin, and his surety, for which execution may issue if necessary.
