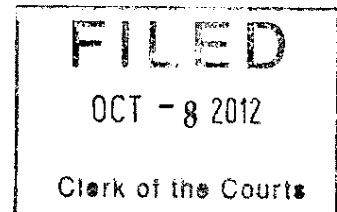

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed by the Board of Professional Responsibility against Anthony Bernard Norris on August 24, 2012; upon an Answer to the Petition for Discipline filed by Mr. Norris on September 13, 2012; upon a Conditional Guilty Plea executed by Mr. Norris on September 18, 2012, and filed with the Board on September 18, 2012; upon an Order Recommending Approval of Conditional Guilty Plea entered by the Hearing Panel on September 19, 2012; upon the Board's approval of the Conditional Guilty Plea on September 21, 2012; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court approves the recommendation of the Hearing Panel and accepts the Conditional Guilty Plea.

It is, therefore, ordered, adjudged, and decreed by the Court that:

1. Anthony Bernard Norris shall be and is hereby suspended for a period of five (5) years pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 4.2.
2. The following conditions precedent to any reinstatement shall apply:
 - a. Mr. Norris shall be required to pay Board of Professional Responsibility registration fees from 1996 to present for which he has never paid.
 - b. Mr. Norris shall be required to pay any Professional Privilege Tax which may be assessed against him in the future by the Department of Revenue for each year that he was engaged in the practice of law.

c. Mr. Norris agrees to dismiss his pending voluntary surrender petition and as a condition precedent to re-filing such a petition must serve the entirety of his suspension and comply with the above conditions.

3. Respondent shall comply in all respects with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 18, regarding the obligations and responsibilities of suspended attorneys.

4. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 24.3, Mr. Norris shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$326.66, and in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.

5. The Board shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 18.10.
