ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

This matter is before the Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c), upon a Petition for Reinstatement filed on June 6, 2025, by Petitioner, Dale Gerard Nowicki. Mr. Nowicki was suspended from the practice of law by reciprocal Order of this Court entered May 13, 2025, for a period of two (2) years with ninety (90) days active suspension retroactive to the date of suspension in California, and the remainder on probation, subject to the conditions specified in the January 6, 2025, Order of the Supreme Court of California. A Notice of Submission was filed by the Chief Disciplinary Counsel indicating the petition is satisfactory to the Board, Mr. Nowicki has satisfied the conditions set forth in this Court's Order imposing reciprocal discipline, and he is eligible for reinstatement and probation.

From all of which, the Court grants the Petition for Reinstatement.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND
DECREED BY THE COURT:

1. The Petitioner, Dale Gerard Nowicki, is hereby reinstated to the practice of law in the State of Tennessee pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c), and the remainder of his two (2) year suspension shall be served on probation.
2. Mr. Nowicki's reinstatement to the active practice of law and grant of probation is conditioned upon his continuing compliance with, and timely satisfaction of, the conditions set forth in the Order of the Supreme Court of California entered January 6, 2025. In the event Mr. Nowicki fails to satisfy any condition of probation as set forth in the January 6, 2025 Order, the grant of probation herein may be revoked pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 14.2.

3. Mr. Nowicki shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for which execution may issue if necessary.
4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
