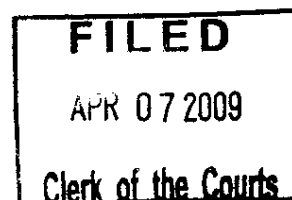

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed on April 28, 2008 by the Board of Professional Responsibility ("Board") against Ramsdale O'DeNeal ("Respondent"); upon Answer of Respondent filed on May 16, 2008; upon a hearing held before a Hearing Panel on November 12, 2008; upon the Opinion of the Hearing Panel entered on January 14, 2009; and upon the entire record in this cause. Neither party has appealed the Opinion of the Hearing Panel.

From all of which the Court adopts the Opinion of the Hearing Panel and concludes that a one (1) year suspension is appropriate.


It is therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Respondent, Ramsdale O'DeNeal, be and is hereby suspended from the practice of law for one (1) year pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 4.2.
2. Respondent shall comply in all aspects with Supreme Court Rule 9, Sections 18 and 19 regarding the obligations and responsibilities of suspended attorneys and the procedure for reinstatement.
3. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 24.3, the Respondent shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$2,497.00 within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order. In addition, Respondent shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.

4. The Board shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18.10.

5. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18.5, this Order shall be effective ten (10) days after the date of entry.
