While his license was suspended, Mr. Officer made several court appearances for clients in Putnam, Overton, and Clay Counties, and engaged in settlement negotiations in two divorce cases.

By the aforementioned acts, Albert Fitzpatrick Officer has violated Rule of Professional Conduct 5.5 (unauthorized practice of law) and is hereby Publicly Censured for this violation.
