## PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against Eric Trygve Olson, #035432, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on June 12, 2020.

Mr. Olson was hired in September 2016 as in-house counsel. At the time, he was licensed in two other states. He did not complete his registration with the Tennessee Board of Law Examiners within 180 days of the start of his employment as required by TENN. SUP. Ct. R. 7 §10.01.

In January 2019, Mr. Olson submitted an application for comity to the BLE and incorrectly stated that he had never registered as in-house counsel. In April 2019, Mr. Olson went to work as in-house counsel for a different company. He did not notify the BLE of his termination with the first company, and he did not register as in-house counsel with the BLE within 180 days of the date that second employment began.

By the aforementioned acts, Eric Trygve Olson has violated Rules of Professional Conduct 5.5 (unauthorized practice of law) and is hereby Publicly Censured for the violations. This public censure is conditioned upon payment of \$538 in registration fee arrears to the Board of Professional Responsibility.
