PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against Lance William Parr, an attorney formerly licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on June 10, 2016.

Mr. Parr discontinued representation of a client, William Straser, due to a previous disbarment. Mr. Parr failed to provide the client file or promptly refund unearned fees to Mr. Straser. Mr. Parr also failed to provide a response to the disciplinary complaint against him.

By these acts, Lance William Parr has violated Rules of Professional Conduct 1.16(d) (terminating representation) and 8.1(b) (disciplinary matters) and he is hereby Publicly Censured for these violations. As a condition of the Public Censure, Mr. Parr is required to reimburse \$600.00 in fees to Mr. Straser within 90 days.
