ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed by the Board of Professional Responsibility ("the Board") against Respondent, Clarence W. Phillips, on July 27, 2007; upon Response to Petition filed by Respondent on August 16, 2007; upon a Conditional Guilty Plea filed by Respondent on February 21, 2008, pursuant to Rule 9, § 16.1 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, which plea has been approved by a Hearing Panel and by the Board; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court accepts the Conditional Guilty Plea and adopts the terms contained therein as the Court's Order.


It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Respondent be and is hereby publicly censured for violating Rules 7.3(a), 7.3(b)(3), 8.4(a) and 8.4(d) of the Rules of Professional Conduct.

2. Pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent shall pay to the Board the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$ 212.38, and in addition shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue, if necessary.

3. The Board shall cause notice of this public censure to be published in the manner set forth in Rule 9, §18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
