**TENNESSEE LAWYER REINSTATED**

On September 27, 2019, the Supreme Court of Tennessee reinstated Kurt Joseph Pomrenke to the practice of law. Mr. Pomrenke had been suspended by the Virginia State Bar Disciplinary Board on November 27, 2018 for a period of nine (9) months. Pursuant to Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 12.2, Mr. Pomrenke was suspended from the practice of law by Order of this Court, dated March 15, 2019. Mr. Pomrenke filed a Petition for Reinstatement to the practice of law pursuant to Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 30.4c. The Board found the Petition satisfactory and submitted an Order of Reinstatement to the Court.

**ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT**

This matter is before the Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c), upon a Petition for Reinstatement filed on September 11, 2019, by the Petitioner, Kurt Joseph Pomrenke. On November 27, 2018, Mr. Pomrenke was suspended from the practice of law for nine (9) months by the Virginia State Bar Disciplinary Board. On March 15, 2019, Mr. Pomrenke was suspended from the practice of law by Order of this Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §§ 12.2 and 25. A Notice of Submission was filed by the Chief Disciplinary Counsel indicating that Mr. Pomrenke has satisfied all conditions set forth in the Order imposing discipline and is eligible for reinstatement, effective September 11, 2019.

From all of which the Court grants the Petition for Reinstatement.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT:

1. The Petitioner, Kurt Joseph Pomrenke, is hereby reinstated to the practice of law in the State of Tennessee, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c).
2. Mr. Pomrenke shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for which execution may issue if necessary.
3. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
