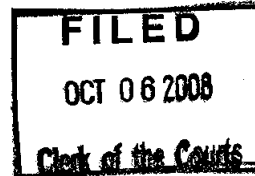

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed on November 6, 2007, by the Board of Professional Responsibility against Blair A. Presson ("Respondent"); upon Response to Petition filed by Respondent on November 26, 2007; upon a Conditional Guilty Plea entered by Respondent on June 10, 2008; upon Order Recommending Approval of Conditional Guilty Plea entered on July 14, 2008, by a Hearing Panel; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court accepts the Conditional Guilty Plea which includes Respondent's agreement to enter into a monitoring agreement with the Tennessee Lawyers Assistance Program ("TLAP") for a period of three (3) years and adopts the Order of the Hearing Panel recommending that Respondent receive a public censure.

It is therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. The Respondent, Blair A. Presson, be and is hereby publicly censured.
2. The Respondent shall continue to comply with the TLAP monitoring agreement as provided in the Conditional Guilty Plea.
3. Pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, the Respondent shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$377.10, and in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.

4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this Public Censure to be published as required by Rule 9, §18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
