## ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 24.3, the Respondent shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$4,839.35 and, in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.
- 3. The Board shall cause notice of this public censure to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18.10.
