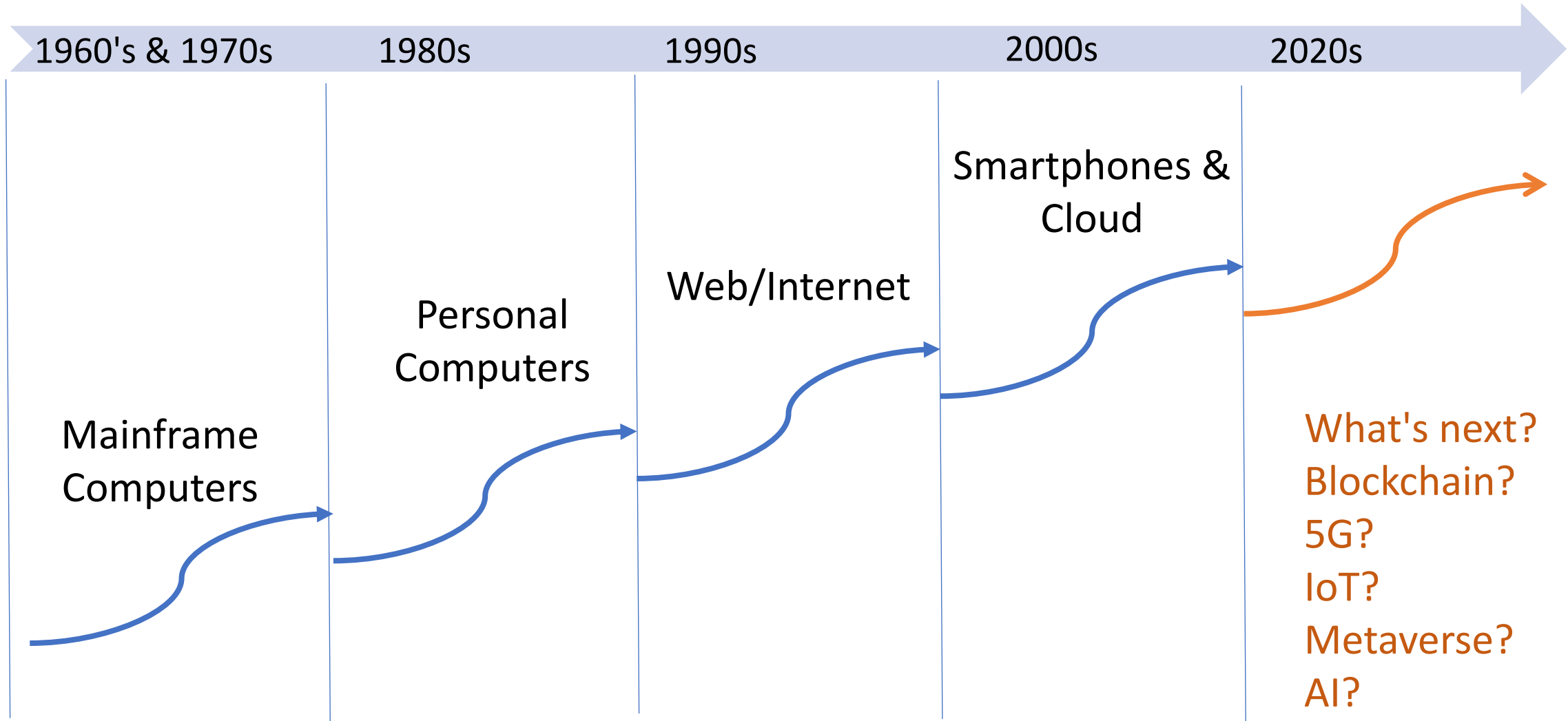
Technology S-Curve

- What is called "biotechnology" is a vital issue that impacts all of us.
- Largely between 1997 and 1999, genetically modified (GM) food ingredients suddenly appeared in *2/3rds of all US processed foods*. This food alteration was fueled by a single Supreme Court ruling. It allowed, for the first time, the patenting of life forms for commercialization. Since then thousands of applications for experimental genetically-modified (GM) organisms, including quite bizarre GMOs, have been filed with the US Patent Office alone, and many more abroad. Furthermore an economic war broke out to own equity in firms that legally claimed such patent rights or the means to control not only genetically modified organisms but vast reaches of human food supplies. This has been the behind-the-scenes and key factor for some of the largest and rapid agri-chemical firm mergers in history. The merger of Pioneer Hi-Bred and Dupont (1997), Novartis AG and AstraZeneca PLC (2000), plus Dow's merger with Rohm and Haas (2001) are three prominent examples. Few consumers are aware this has been going on and is ever continuing. Yet if you recently ate soya sauce in a Chinese restaurant, munched popcorn in a movie theatre, or indulged in an occasional candy bar - you've undoubtedly ingested this new type of food. You may have, at the time, known exactly how much salt, fat and carbohydrates were in each of these foods because regulations mandate their labeling for dietary purposes. But you would not know if the bulk of these foods, and literally every cell had been genetically altered!

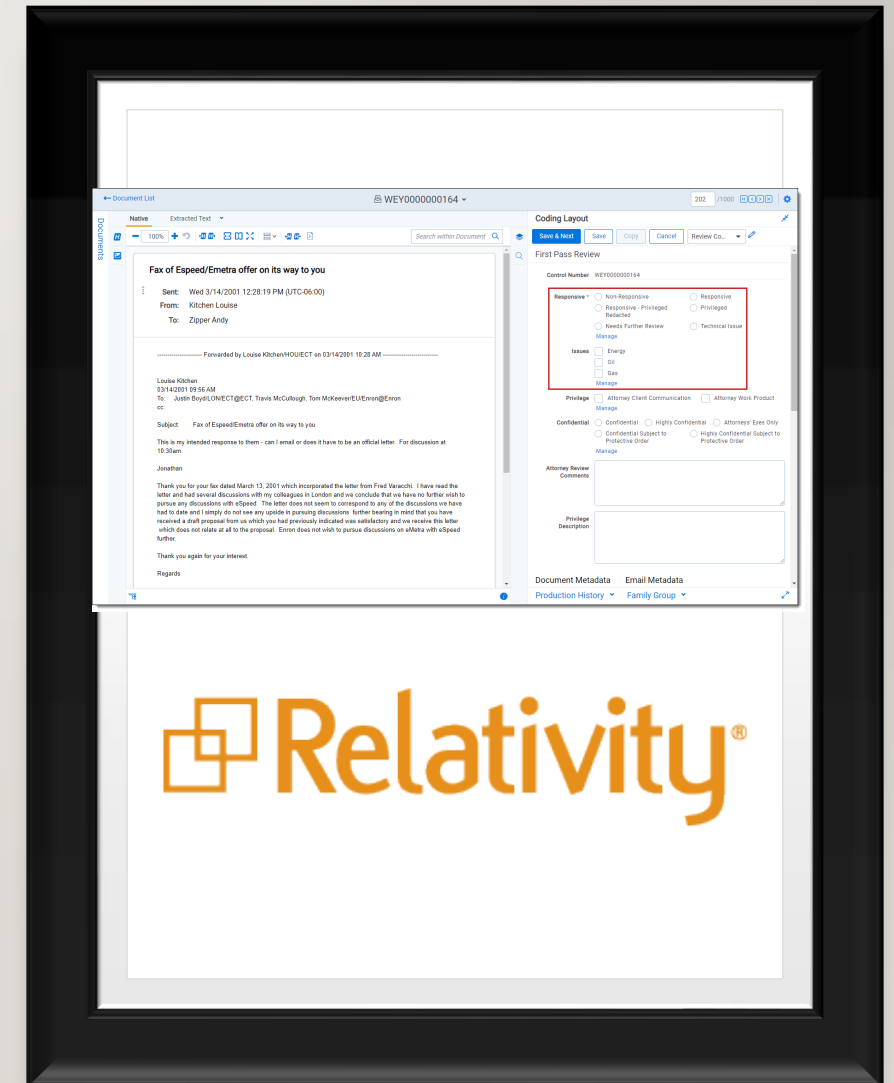
CHARACTERISTICS OF E-DISCOVERY CASE

- Routine collection of documents from a targeted list of custodians
- Filter parameters are well-defined
- Custodians have no personal stake in the discovery process
- No allegations of data destruction have been made
- E-Discovery engineer not typically called to testify as expert witness
- Typical Output: Document database exported to a review tool

CHARACTERISTICS OF DIGITAL FORENSICS CASE

- Suspicion exists of malicious destruction or alteration of digital data
- Custodians have personal stake in findings
- Scope of investigation unknown initially
- Experience and skill of investigator critically important
- Typical Output: Computer Forensics Expert Report
- May be called to testify as expert witness

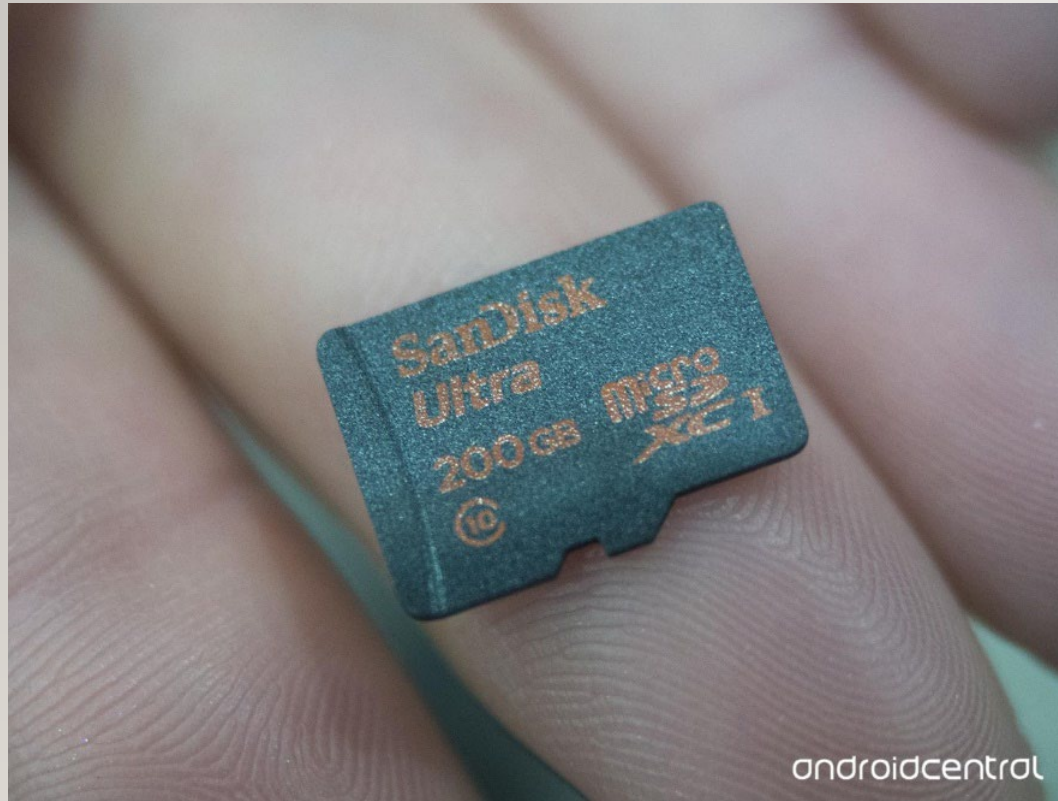

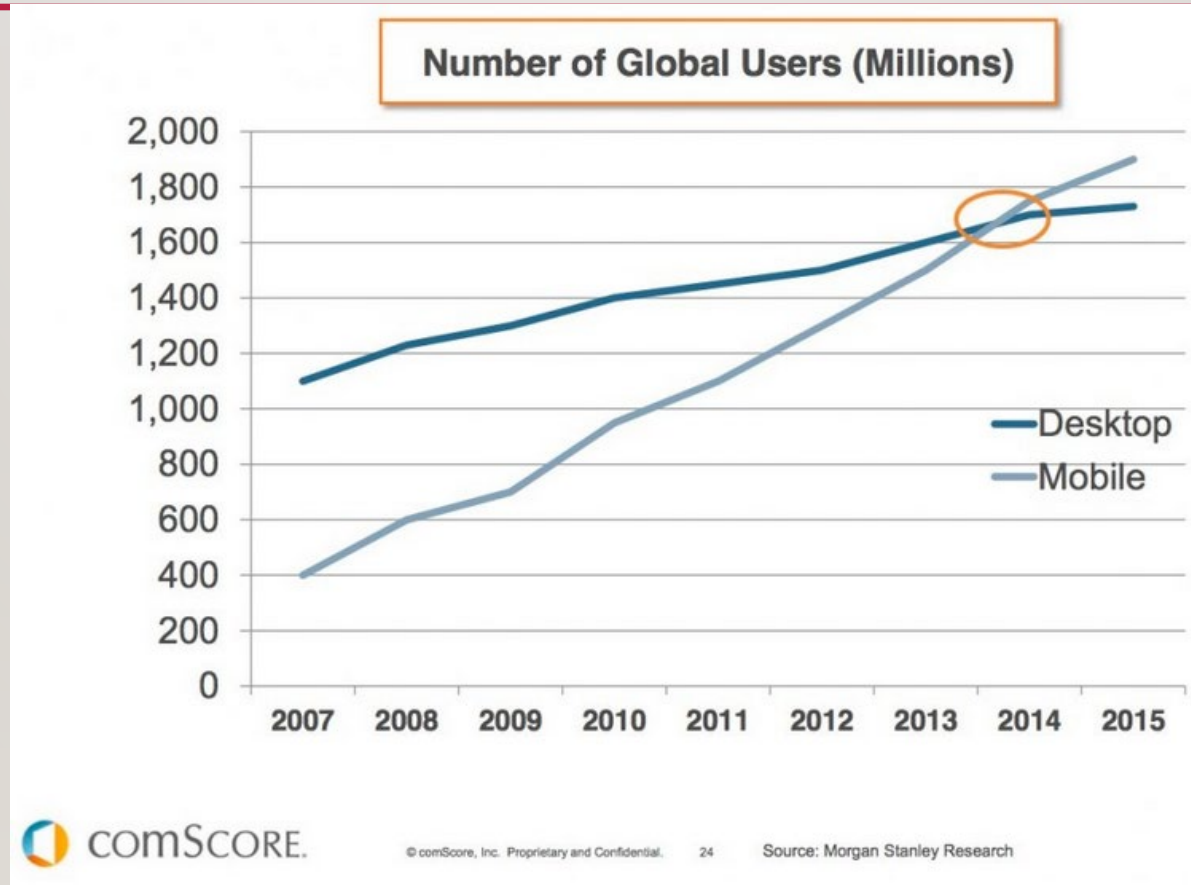




DIGITAL METADATA

- Metadata is data about data
- External & Internal metadata
- Important to keep intact
 - Easily altered during collection & examination
- Can help to identify when data was created, moved and/or modified
- Can help identify the location of an event
 - Geolocation

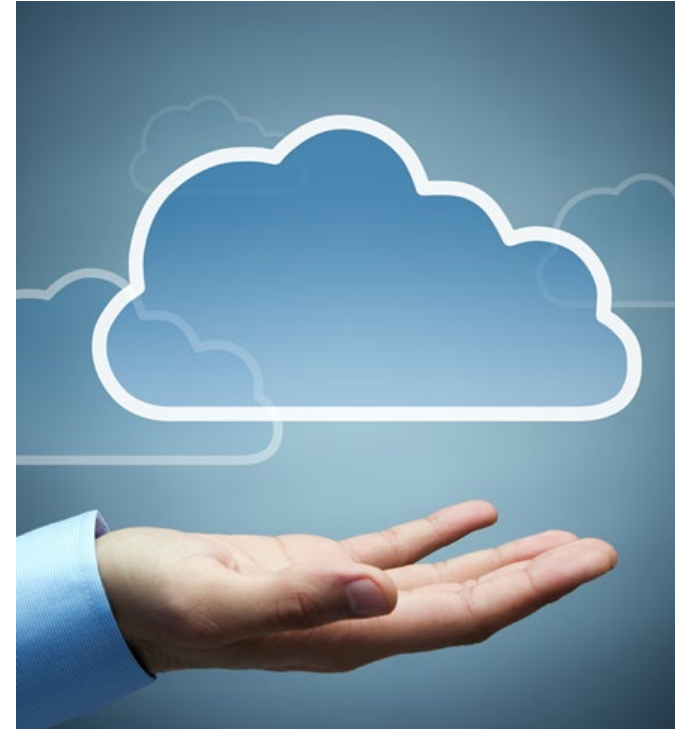
A lawyer may ethically allow confidential client information to be stored in “the cloud” if the lawyer takes reasonable care to **assure** that:

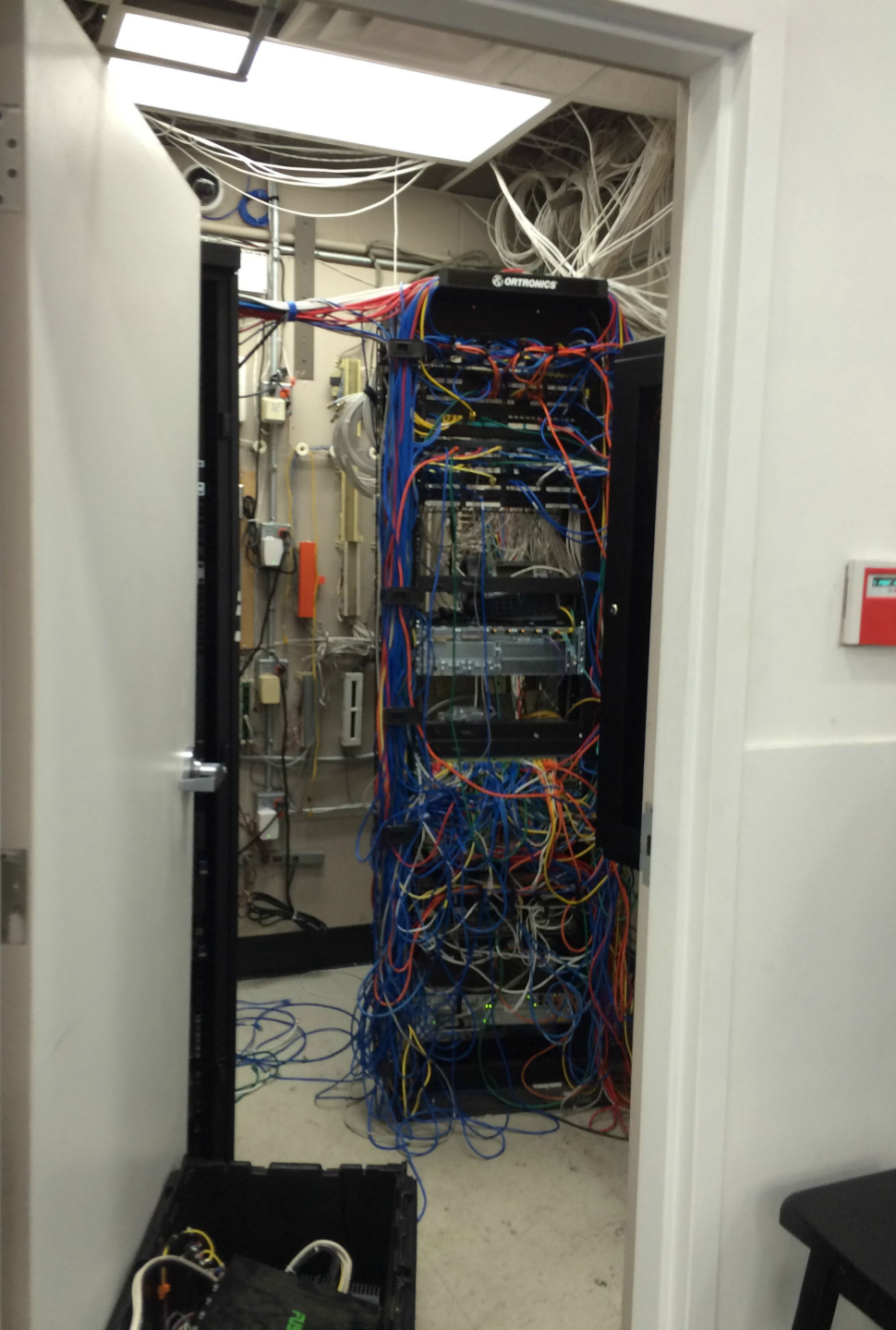
- 1) all such information or materials remain confidential; and

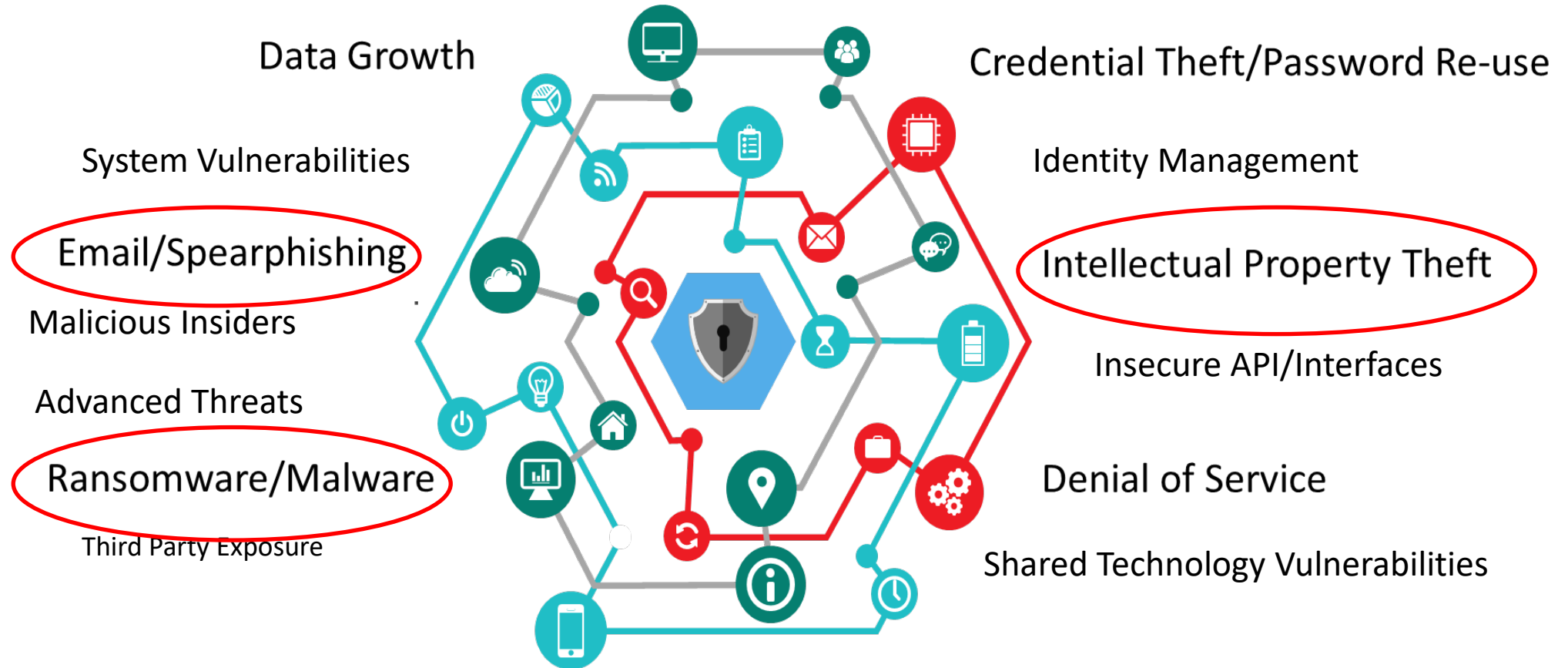

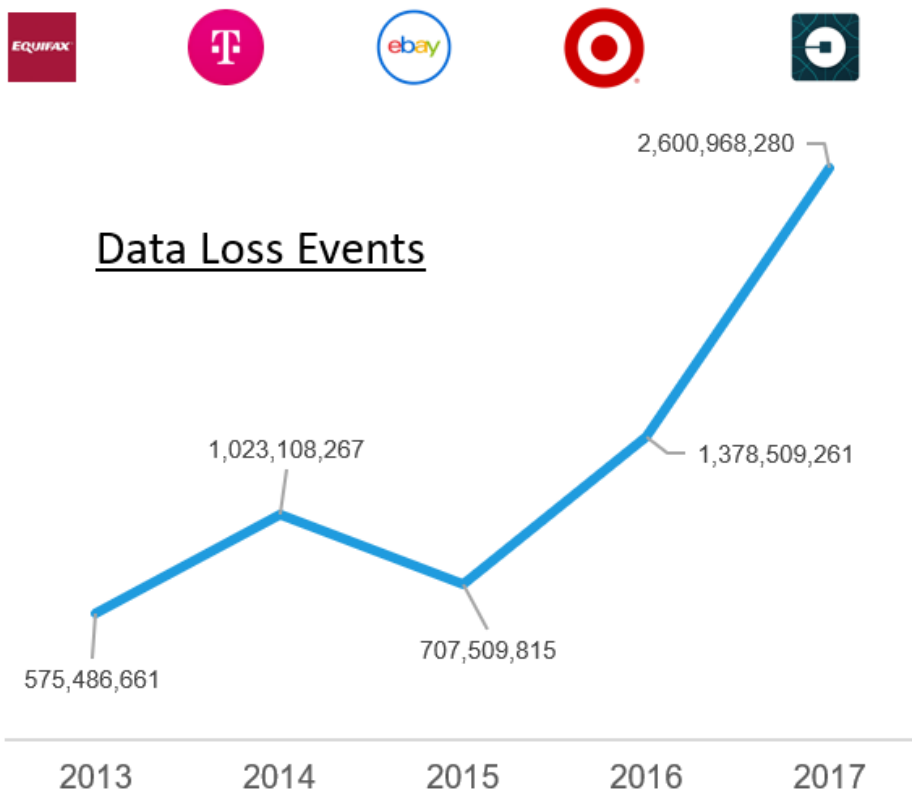

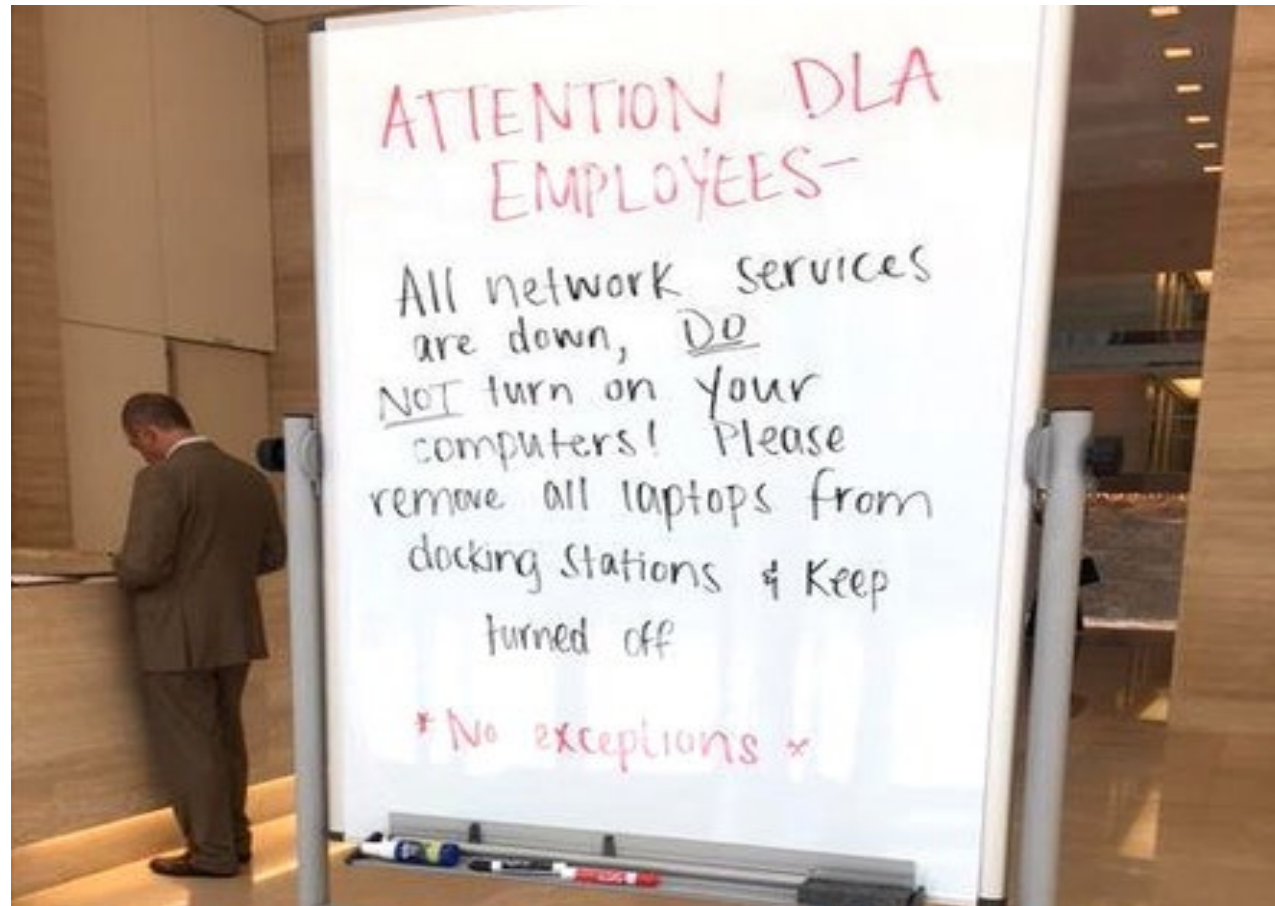
1. Set a tone for cybersecurity at top and appoint CISO/CIO to be in charge
2. Inventory and evaluate risk of all software systems and data
3. Establish critical points of contact: internet service providers, law enforcement, data forensic experts
4. Regular training/awareness programs for all staff
5. Multifactor authentication for any application accessible via internet

Top 10 Recommendations (cont)

6. Take out cyber insurance policy
7. Conduct gap analysis of firm's cybersecurity position
8. Continually test for vulnerabilities
 - ▶ Annual penetration testing by an independent third party
 - ▶ Monthly vulnerability testing
9. Enable encryption on all devices that can store sensitive data (laptops, desktops, smartphones, tablets, etc.)
10. Deploy data loss protection systems

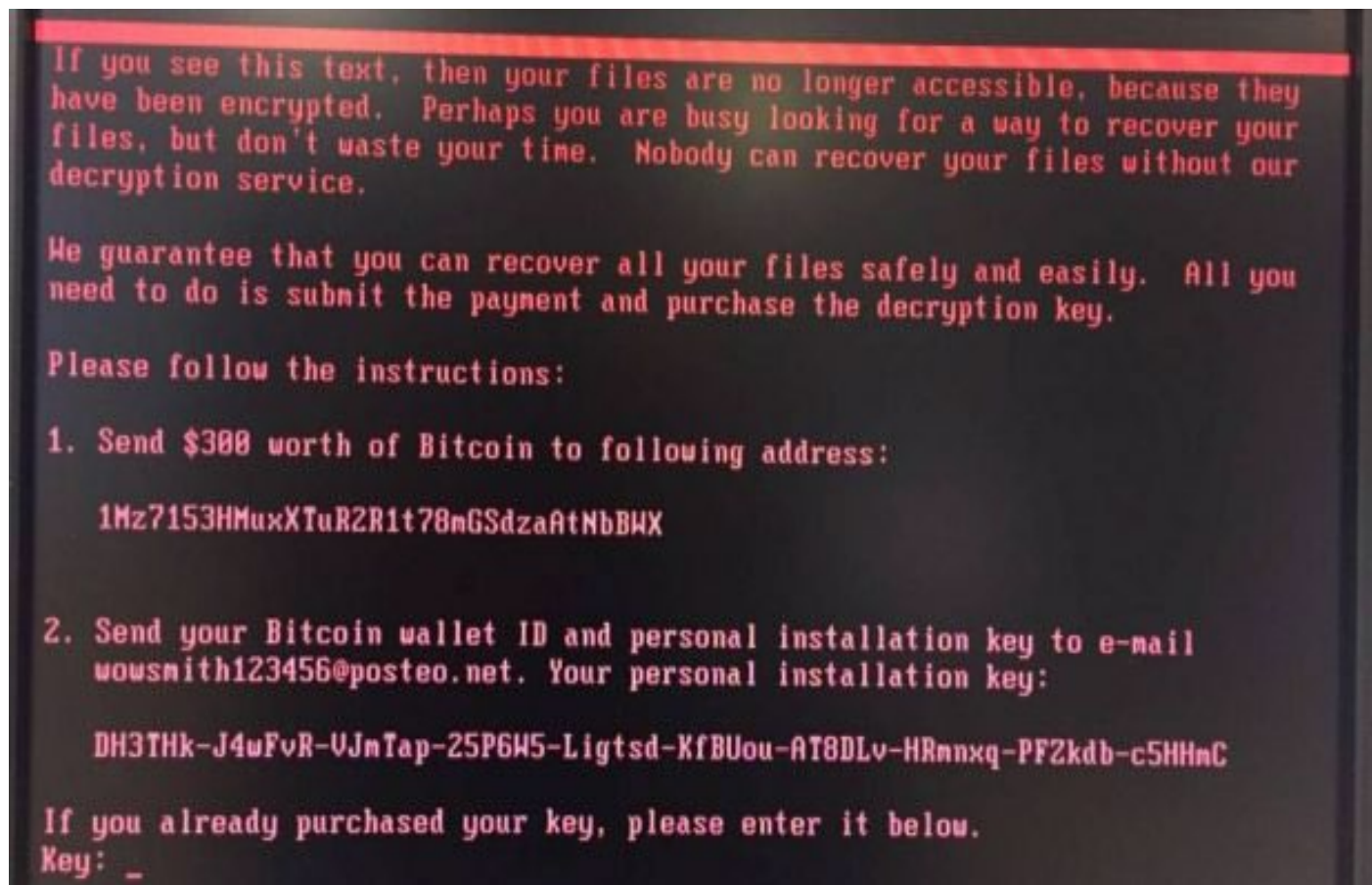

Ransomware Attacks Against Attorneys

DLA Piper (June 27, 2017):

- Firm infected by Petya malware.
- Entire 3,600 lawyers + support staff in 40 countries on digital lockdown.
- Lockdown wasn't fully remediated for weeks.
 - 1 day without phones
 - 6 days without email
 - 2 weeks without complete access to older email and documents
- Total direct and indirect costs to firm estimated to be millions of dollars.

Ransomware Attacks Against Attorneys

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Ransomware Attacks Against Attorneys

Moses Afonson Ryan, Ltd. (May, 2015)

- 10 person law firm located in Providence, RI
- Attorney at firm opened an email attachment from an unknown source which was encoded with a ransomware encrypted virus that infected firm's computer network.
- All of the information and documents on firm's computer network became disabled and its network was rendered inoperable.
- Hacker demanded \$25,000 in ransom paid in bitcoin to restore access to firm's system. Firm negotiated ransom to be paid in bitcoins.
- During the seizure, the firm's 10 lawyers were left unproductive = \$700,000 in lost billings.



NY Real Estate Attorney Malpractice Claims (April, 2016)

- Attorney used AOL email account to communicate involving clients' purchase of a \$19,380,000 condo.
- Cybercriminals hacked into the account, impersonated the attorney, and tricked her clients into wiring a \$1.9 million dollar security deposit into a fraudulent bank account.
- Complaint alleged attorney failed to take basic cybersecurity measures and lacked awareness of same.



Malpractice Claims

Malpractice Claim Filed Against NY Real Estate Attorney (April, 2016)

43. To represent the Millards competently and protect the Millards (and other clients) from cybercrime and other crime, Doran had a duty to take reasonable and necessary security precautions, such as the installation of appropriate protective software and the use of two-factor authentication. Doran had a duty to take measures including but not limited to the following:

- a. Reasonable measures to secure Doran's client files, and communications with clients.
- b. Reasonable measures to secure Doran's email account and computer, including the data contained within them, from unauthorized third parties.
- c. Reasonable measures to prevent Doran's email account from being used by unauthorized third parties.
- d. A strict policy of orally confirming instructions for the electronic transfer of funds belonging to clients. This policy should include advance notification to clients that funds should not be transferred unless Doran orally confirmed any emailed instructions.
- e. Oral confirmation, following the electronic transfer of funds, to establish that the funds were actually received by the intended party.
- f. The immediate investigation of any incident involving crime or cybercrime, to determine its cause, its perpetrator, and the possibility of remedying or mitigating any loss.
- g. The preservation of all Electronically Stored Information (ESI).
