ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court upon the Petition of Disciplinary Counsel for the temporary suspension of Charles Mark Pullen from the practice of law pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9. The Petition has been authorized by the Chairman of the Board of Professional Responsibility. The Petition is supported by the Affidavit of Ted Rice, Assistant Director of Tennessee Lawyers Assistance Program (TLAP). Based upon the Petition and supporting Affidavit, the Court finds that Charles Mark Pullen, Respondent, has failed to comply with his TLAP contract and was suspended from the TLAP Program.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court:

1. That Charles Mark Pullen is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9.
2. That Charles Mark Pullen shall comply with Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects, and particularly as provided in Section 18.
3. That Charles Mark Pullen, Respondent, may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Supreme Court Rule 9.
4. That the Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Charles Mark Pullen to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9.
