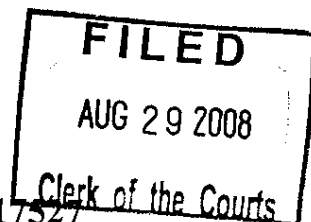

**ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION**


This matter is before the Court upon a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Suzanne Shackelford Queen from the practice of law, pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the Affidavit of William W. Hunt, III, Disciplinary Counsel.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting Affidavit, the Court finds that Suzanne Shackelford Queen has failed to respond to the Board of Professional Responsibility concerning a complaint of misconduct, File No. 31034-1-TH.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Suzanne Shackelford Queen is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Section 4.3, Rule 9, of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Tennessee.
2. Suzanne Shackelford Queen shall comply with Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects, and particularly as provided in Section 18.
3. Suzanne Shackelford Queen may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Supreme Court Rule 9.
4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Suzanne Shackelford Queen to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9.
