## ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court on a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Andre Chase Rabideau from the practice of law, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the Affidavit of Michael C. Brett, Disciplinary Counsel.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting Affidavit, the Court finds that Andre Chase Rabideau, Respondent, failed to respond to the Board of Professional Responsibility concerning a complaint of misconduct in File No. 71354c-4-MB.

- 1. Andre Chase Rabideau is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3.
- 2. Andre Chase Rabideau shall comply with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9 in all respects and particularly as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28, regarding the responsibilities of suspended attorneys.
- 3. Andre Chase Rabideau may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3.
- 4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Andre Chase Rabideau to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
