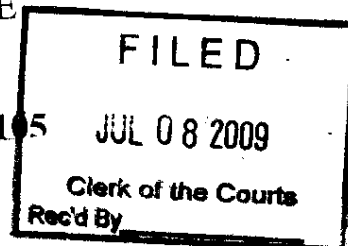

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon the Petition for Discipline filed on July 7, 2008; upon Response to the Petition for Discipline filed by Respondent; upon a Conditional Guilty Plea entered by Respondent on April 20, 2009; upon a Hearing Panel Order recommending approval of the Conditional Guilty Plea entered on April 29, 2009, and approval by the Board on June 12, 2009; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court accepts the recommendation of the Hearing Panel and concludes that the Conditional Guilty Plea imposing a three (3) year suspension is appropriate.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 4.2, the Respondent, Fernando Jose Ramos, is hereby suspended for a period of three years from the effective date of this order.
2. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 24.3, the Respondent shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$363.49, and in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.
3. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18.10.
4. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18.5, this order shall be effective ten (10) days after the date of entry.
