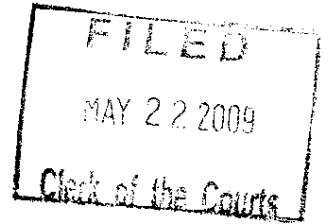

**ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT**

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed on December 29, 2008, by the Board of Professional Responsibility against Ronald R. Reagan ("Respondent"); upon a Judgment of the Hearing Panel filed March 6, 2009, from which no appeal has been taken, and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court accepts the Judgment of the Hearing Panel and concludes that the Judgment is appropriate. Specifically, Respondent shall be suspended for five (5) years.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. The Respondent, Ronald R. Reagan, is suspended from the practice of law for five (5) years.
2. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 24.3, the Respondent shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$357.07, and in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.
2. The Respondent shall comply in all aspects with Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18, regarding the obligations and responsibilities of suspended attorneys.
3. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this discipline to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18.10.
4. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18.5, this Order shall be effective ten (10) days after the date of entry.
