ORDER DISSOLVING TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

On November 1, 2023, an Order of Temporary Suspension was entered against Robert Redman Laser, III, for failing to respond to the Board of Professional Responsibility ("Board") concerning a complaint of misconduct. On September 25, 2024, Mr. Laser filed a Petition for Dissolution and Reinstatement demonstrating he has responded to the disciplinary complaint, has complied with all conditions imposed by the Order of Temporary Suspension, and has provided his affidavit in compliance with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.

On October 4, 2024, the Board filed a response with this Court admitting that it has received a sufficient response to the disciplinary complaint from Petitioner and has resolved the underlying disciplinary complaint pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 13. The Board further admits that Mr. Laser has complied with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28, and that, considering all these circumstances, good cause exists to dissolve the November 1, 2023, Order of Temporary Suspension.

Based upon the foregoing facts and circumstances, the Court is convinced that no hearing on the petition to dissolve under Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3(d) is necessary and that Mr. Laser is entitled to immediate dissolution of the temporary suspension.

- IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:
- 1. The temporary suspension imposed upon Robert Redman Laser, III, by Order of Temporary Suspension entered November 1, 2023, is hereby dissolved.
- 2. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
