Connie Reguli*, Docket No. W-CR190482 (attached as Exhibit A), demonstrating Connie Lynn Reguli, a Tennessee attorney, was found guilty of Facilitation of Felony (TCA § 39-11-403), Accessory After the Fact – Aiding (TCA § 39-11-411) and Accessory After the Fact – Harboring (TCA § 39-11-411).

- 3. Connie Lynn Reguli shall fully comply with the provisions of Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28, concerning disbarred or suspended attorneys; and
- 4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
