WILLIAMSON COUNTY LAWYER SUSPENDED

On April 22, 2022, the Tennessee Supreme Court suspended Connie Lynn Reguli from the practice of law until further orders of the Court pursuant to Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 22.3. Ms. Reguli was found guilty in the Circuit Criminal Court for Williamson County in *State of Tennessee v. Connie Reguli*, Docket No. W-CR190482, of Facilitation of Felony – Custodial Interference; Accessory After the Fact – Aiding; and Accessory After the Fact – Harboring.

Pursuant to the Order of the Supreme Court, the matter has been referred to the Board to institute formal proceedings to determine the extent of the final discipline to be imposed upon Ms. Reguli as a result of her conviction of a serious crime.

Ms. Reguli must comply with the requirements of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Sections 28 and 30.4, regarding the obligations and responsibilities of suspended attorneys.

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §§ 22.1 and 22.3, upon a Notice of Submission filed by Disciplinary Counsel for the Board of Professional Responsibility consisting of a certified copy of the Verdict Form, entered April 20, 2022, in the Circuit Court for Williamson County in the matter of *State of Tennessee v. Connie Reguli*, Docket No. W-CR190482 (attached as Exhibit A), demonstrating Connie Lynn Reguli, a Tennessee attorney, was found guilty of Facilitation of Felony (TCA § 39-11-403), Accessory After the Fact – Aiding (TCA § 39-11-411) and Accessory After the Fact – Harboring (TCA § 39-11-411).

IT IS THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

1. Connie Lynn Reguli is suspended from the practice of law on this date pending further orders of this Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 22.3;
2. This matter is referred to the Board of Professional Responsibility for the institution of a formal proceeding in which the sole issue to be determined shall be the extent of the final discipline;
3. Connie Lynn Reguli shall fully comply with the provisions of Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28, concerning disbarred or suspended attorneys; and
4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
