PUBLIC CENSURE



The above complaint was filed against Arvin H. Reingold, #1621 an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on December 12, 2014.

Mr. Reingold failed to act with reasonable diligence and failed to maintain reasonable communication with his client in conjunction with summary judgment that was entered against her. As a result of Mr. Reingold's failure to inform his client that her case was dismissed she lost her right to an appeal.

By the aforementioned acts, Arvin Reingold has violated Rules of Professional Conduct 1.3 (diligence) and 1.4 (communication) and is hereby Publicly Censured for these violations.
