PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against Summer M. Rhoden, #033802, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on June 14, 2019.

Ms. Rhoden's son, Sebastian Vaughn, was charged with first-degree murder on July 6, 2017. Mr. Vaughn appeared at Ms. Rhoden's home on the afternoon of July 6, 2017. Ms. Rhoden failed to contact law enforcement or facilitate Mr. Vaughn's surrender until the following morning. Ms. Rhoden was charged as an accessory after the fact as a result of this delay. Ms. Rhoden pled guilty on March 8, 2019 to a reduced misdemeanor charge of criminal attempt.

By these acts, Summer M. Rhoden has violated Rule of Professional Conduct 8.4(b) (criminal conduct) and is hereby Publicly Censured for this violation.
