
PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against Keisha Moses Richardson, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on September 11, 2020.

Ms. Richardson was convicted by a jury of Violation of an Order of Protection which was affirmed on appeal. Ms. Richardson's conduct reflected adversely upon her fitness as a lawyer and she failed to respond to the disciplinary complaint against her.

By the aforementioned acts, Keisha Moses Richardson has violated Rule of Professional Conduct 8.1(b) (disciplinary matters) and 8.4(a)(b)(d)(g) (misconduct), and is hereby Publicly Censured for these violations.
