## ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court on a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Christopher Shawn Roberts from the practice of law pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the Declaration of J.E. "Buddy" Stockwell, III, Executive Director of the Tennessee Lawyer Assistance Program ("TLAP").

Based upon the Petition and the supporting Declaration, the Court finds that Christopher Shawn Roberts, Respondent, is substantially non-compliant with his TLAP monitoring agreement as detailed by the Declaration of J.E. "Buddy" Stockwell, III.

- IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:
- 1. Christopher Shawn Roberts is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3.
- 2. Christopher Shawn Roberts shall comply with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9 in all respects and particularly as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28, regarding the responsibilities of suspended attorneys.
- 3. Christopher Shawn Roberts may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3.
- 4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Christopher Shawn Roberts to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
