ORDER TRANSFERRING ATTORNEY TO DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS

This matter is before the Court upon a Notice of Contention of Disability Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 27.4(a). Upon due consideration of the statements from Ms. Sankar to the Board and the information the Board received from the Tennessee Lawyers Assistance Program, it is CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

- 1. The law license of Sornavidya Saba Sankar shall be transferred to disability inactive status for an indefinite period of time and until further orders of the Supreme Court. Further, all disciplinary proceedings against Ms. Sankar shall be suspended until further Orders of this Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, Section 27.4(c)
- 2. Ms. Sankar shall comply with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9 in all respects and particularly as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28, regarding the responsibilities of attorneys transferred to disability inactive status.
- 3. Ms. Sankar shall be allowed to petition for reinstatement to active status pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 27.7.
- 4. The Board shall publish notice of this transfer pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §§ 27.5 and 28.11.
- 5. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 32.4, documents other than this Order relating to Ms. Sankar's disability proceeding shall not be public records and shall be kept confidential.
