**MURFREESBORO LAWYER PLACED ON DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS**

On June 11, 2012, the law license of Murfreesboro lawyer, Jerry Scott was transferred to disability inactive status by the Tennessee Supreme Court pursuant to Section 21 of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9.

Mr. Scott cannot practice law while on disability inactive status. He may return to the practice of law after reinstatement by the Tennessee Supreme Court upon showing of clear and convincing evidence that the disability has been removed and he is fit to resume the practice of law.

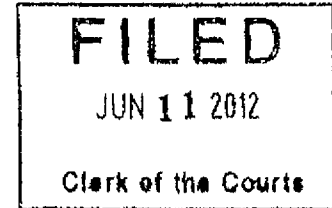

**ORDER TRANSFERRING ATTORNEY TO DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS**

This matter is before the Court upon the Petition to Transfer Attorney Jerry Scott to disability inactive status, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 21.2.

Upon due consideration of medical documentation submitted by Utpal P. Patel, M.D., the Court concludes that Jerry Scott is currently incapacitated from continuing the practice of law.

It is, therefore, ordered, adjudged, and decreed by the Court that:

1. The law license of Jerry Scott shall be transferred to disability inactive status for an indefinite period of time and until further orders of the Supreme Court.
2. Jerry Scott shall be allowed to petition for reinstatement to active status pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 21.6.
3. The Board shall publish notice of this transfer pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §§ 21.4 and 21.5.
4. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 25.2, documents other than this Order relating to Jerry Scott's disability proceeding shall not be public records and shall be kept confidential.
5. Costs are taxed to Jerry Scott.
