ORDER DISSOLVING TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court pursuant to a Notice of Submission filed by the Board of Professional Responsibility (“Board”) indicating Melanie Beth Shada accepted a public censure issued by the Board on October 24, 2024, which resolved the disciplinary matter upon which her temporary suspension was based. The notice also provides that Ms. Shada is administratively suspended for failure to pay annual registration fees.
