**SHELBY COUNTY LAWYER CENSURED**

On April 18, 2019, Joyce Diane Bradley, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, received a Public Censure from the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Tennessee Supreme Court.

On August 22, 2018, Ms. Bradley's license to practice law was suspended for CLE noncompliance. Notwithstanding the administrative suspension, Ms. Bradley continued to practice law thereafter by appearing in court and discussing clients' cases with other attorneys.

By these acts, Ms. Bradley is in violation of Rule of Professional Conduct 5.5 (unauthorized practice of law) and is hereby Publicly Censured for this violation.

A Public Censure is a rebuke and warning to the attorney, but it does not affect the attorney's ability to practice law.

PUBLIC CENSURE



The above complaint was filed against Joyce Diane Bradley, #015784, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on March 8, 2019.

On August 22, 2018, the Respondent's license to practice law was suspended for CLE noncompliance. Notwithstanding the administrative suspension, the Respondent continued to practice law thereafter by appearing in court and discussing clients' cases with other attorneys.

By practicing law while her license to do so was suspended, the Respondent violated Rule 5.5 and is hereby Publicly Censured for this violation.
