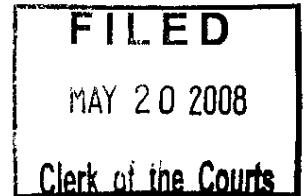

ORDER OF DISBARMENT

This matter is before the Court upon the Affidavit of Respondent, Drayton Beecher Smith, II, an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Tennessee who is subject to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Court pursuant to Rule 9 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.

It appearing to the Court that Respondent has delivered to the Board of Professional Responsibility ("the Board") an Affidavit in compliance with Rule 9, § 15.1 of the Rules of the Supreme Court; and


It further appearing to the Court that Respondent has consented to disbarment because he cannot successfully defend himself on the charges set forth in the Petitions for Discipline filed against him which allege that he has violated Rule 8.4(a)(b)(c)(d) of the Tennessee Rules of Professional Conduct.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Respondent is hereby disbarred from the practice of law in Tennessee.
2. This Order of Disbarment shall be a matter of public record.
3. Pursuant to Rule 9, § 15.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, the Affidavit filed by Respondent shall not be publicly disclosed or made available for use in any other proceeding except upon order of this Court.
4. Respondent shall comply with the requirements and obligations of disbarred attorneys as established in Rule 9, § 18 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.

5. The Board shall cause notice of this disbarment to be published in accordance with Rule 9, § 18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
